Our school is flying the "Progressive Pride" flag which includes the traditional rainbow colours plus black and brown to represent people of colour, and pink, baby blue & white to represent trans people. The world's largest pride flag was displayed in Florida in 2003 and was just over 2 km long, weighing 3 tonnes and needed 2000 people to hold it up!
