### **Student Transfer Application Process**

Dear Parents and Guardians,

You may have received an emailed transition letter last month which indicates where your child will attend next school year, based on their catchment. Please check all email and junk email folders in search of this letter. If your family wishes to apply for a transfer to a different school for the 2025/2026 school year, please read the important information below.

Transfer application forms will be added to the Greater Victoria School District website (see the link below) on February 7 at 4:00 pm for families to download and print. In addition, students can pick up a hard copy from the school office beginning **February 10.** Students are to return the completed transfer applications to their current school's office during the transfer period from February 10–13. Transfer application forms will not be accepted at school offices prior to **February 10.** Transfer applications will be determined in accordance with student enrolment priorities and, therefore, there is no advantage in submitting transfer applications early. Please submit your application form at your convenience during the communicated dates.
