Basketball season is coming to an end with final games next week and playoffs starting for our competitive teams.

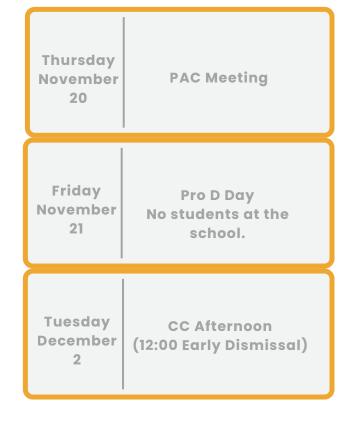

#### **Caffeinated energy drinks:**

We are asking for your help with an unfortunate rise in the popularity of energy drinks amongst students. Staff are noticing that more and more students are bringing energy drinks to school and wanting to drink them in class. There are many "energy drink" products currently sold in Canada. They are available in corner stores, gas stations and grocery stores usually displayed alongside soft drinks, juices and sports drinks. Some of the brand names include, but are not limited to:

- Red Bull Energy Drink
- Impulse Energy Drink
- 5 -hour ENERGY
- Prime
- Monster
- Rockstar
- SoBe Adrenaline Rush
- YJ Stinger



There is a misconception that these drinks quench your thirst and rehydrate your body after periods of intense physical activity but rather than re-hydrate your body, these drinks may actually lead to dehydration. There is also a concern that high sugar snacks and drinks can produce short bursts of energy (lasting 15 – 20 minutes only) but are often followed by a drop in blood sugar and a drop in energy. This drop leaves people feeling tired and irritable, making it difficult to concentrate. These energy drinks are also high in caffeine and may cause adverse reactions as noted on the Health Canada Website and are not recommended for children under 14. http://recalls-rappels.canada.ca/en/alert-recall/caffeinated-energy-drinks-what-you-should-knowl

Health professionals agree that water is the best choice to keep children hydrated. The next best choices are milk, calcium fortified beverages such as soy or rice milk or 100% fruit or vegetable juices.

Please make sure that your children do not bring energy drinks to school and, as a policy, we will ask them to put them away until the end of the day if they bring them to school.

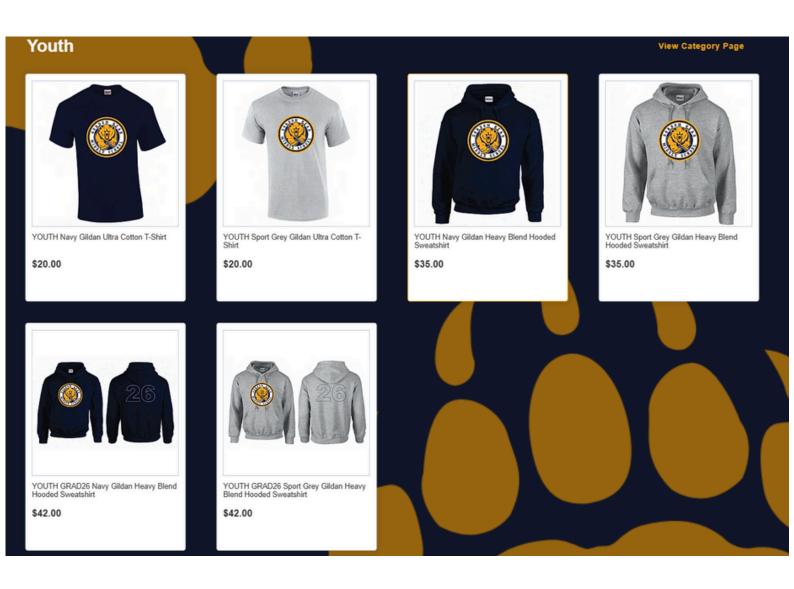

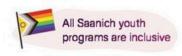
